Corrections

It has been pointed out that the 31st Edition referred to BRIG Martins as our first DGEME and founding HOC. This is incorrect; the correct wording should be "...the first DEME, BRIG Martins, and the fifth HOC...". Thank you to Bert Barker from Queensland for spotting the mistake.

Included over the page is a list of Heads of Corps, whether in their full time roles as Directors of the Engineering Branch – Director Mechanical Engineering (DME), Director Electrical and Mechanical Engineering (DEME), or Director General, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering (DGEME) – to the current system of a Head of Corps, whereby a Brigadier has the extra-Regimental duty of performing the Head of Corps role. Also included is a list of the Corps RSMs dating back to the first one – WO1 David Packer in 2002. Prior to 2000, the Senior Warrant Officer was usually the RSM of the RAEME Training Centre.



RAEME History

The following is a list of the AEME/RAEME Heads of Corps from BRIG F Field, the HOC at our formation on the 1st of Dec 1942 through to BRIG HJ Kohl, the current HOC. The position of Corps RSM as an extra-Regimental duty was instituted in 2000, with the first being WO1 Packer. Prior to that, the Senior Warrant Officer was usually the RSM of RTC. The RAEME 75th Anniversary Logo



The logo is the traditional RAEME Corps emblem with the formation and current year, and the Anniversary number formed in a circular fashion with the RAEME emblem scroll and wattle. This emblem has been used for the 50th Anniversary in 1992 when the Colonel-in-Chief, Prince Phillip, Duke of Edinburgh attended the parade at the Australian War Memorial. This emblem provides a strong link with the past while remaining current with Army's Branding rules.
